Bob Inglis to deliver USC Upstate address

U.S. Rep. Bob Inglis will deliver the graduation address as the University of South Carolina Upstate holds its convocation honoring December graduates at 7 p.m. today at Spartanburg Memorial Auditorium.

The university expects nearly 450 students to graduate.

Also during the ceremony, the USC Upstate Alumni Association will present C. Dan Adams with the 2008 Distinguished Alumnus of the Year award.

Adams, who earned a bachelor's degree in business from the university in 1983 and lives in Greenville, is the president and CEO of The Capital Corporation. He serves as chairman of the board of First National Bank of the South and is a board member of several privately held companies in the Southeast.
